Dunedin and Otago Peninsula Full-Day Nature Tour

Make the most of your visit to Dunedin, the oldest city in New Zealand, on a full-day tour. Be picked up from your central accommodation or from Port Chalmers, and begin your tour with a scenic drive of Dunedin's city highlights. Visit New Zealand's oldest university, the historic Dunedin Railway Station, and Baldwin Street, the steepest street in the world. Journey out onto the Otago Peninsula to explore Larnach Castle's unique gardens where you will have the opportunity to purchase lunch.

Milford Sound Waterfalls, Peaks, and Wildlife Cruise

Christchurch to Queenstown: Full-Day South Island Tour

Pass Middle Earth's Edoras, the mythical capital city of the Rohan people. Be transported back in time while enjoying a nostalgic and comfortable wagon ride. Sit on the sprung wagon with rubber tires and lounge-type seats as you are pulled by a team of Clydesdale horses.





Waipara Wine Trail Tour from Christchurch
